

Kennedy to autograph copies of town history

WESTFORD — With the second printing of "Westford Recollections 1729-1979" due from the presses Thursday, the author, Mrs. June W. Kennedy, will this weekend autograph and personalize each copy of Westford's first history in a century.

She will appear at the Book-tique, 6 Carlisle Place, Minot's Corner on Thursday evening from 6 to 9 p.m.; Friday from 4 to 6 p.m.; and Sunday from 1 to 5 p.m. The first printing of this factual book, loaded with old-time photos and pertinent facts was practically sold out before the initial order of 1,000 had been released.

The reprint order for 500 additional copies, made in October, is now in the bindery of The Murray Printing Company. Mrs. Kennedy reports that half of these were ordered over the past several weeks, many for Christmas gift-giving.

A Westford resident for more than a score of years, the author has reason to be proud of her community, her publishing efforts and the quick response of townspeople in their praise of "Recollections".
