The 15 foot cupola that contains an iron bell which sat on top of the Roudenbush Community Center in Westford will be taken down. The tower has been dangerously leaning toward the street since it was blown out of place late Saturday night early Sunday morning by the strong

winds. The building, located in Westford Center, was built in 1897 by the trustees of Westford Academy. The structure had been in continuous use up until 1955. Corey Steeple Wreckers will remove the steeple.
