over the United States, also in Canada, England, Ireland and Mexico. Each tile is backed with cork imported from Portugal so that they may be used as hot plates on tables. In addition, a ring is on the back so the plaques may be hung as a wall decoration.

The distribution of the tiles is limited to one thousand, they are selling for \$4 and the proceeds will go to the town museum which is pressed for funds. The historical commission is the sponsor. Should a re-order be required, the cost will advance, so early purchase is suggested.

Distribution of the tiles is now being made through local banks and organizations such as the library, the Houdensbush Community Center, League of Women Voters, Academy school store, Tadnuck Women's Club, Golden Agers, Daughters of the American Revolution, Junior choir of the First Church, and the Grange.
