

W.A. Trustees will recognize 107 grads with \$50,000 in scholarships June 2

Over 100 graduates of Westford Academy this year have been recognized for outstanding work in grants of \$50,000, Eileen Anderson, newly-elected president of the Board of Trustees announced this week

There were 114 applications reviewed and 107 were approved, according to Lloyd Blanchard, chairman of the committee on scholarships

Each of the 30 National Honor students was presented with reference books, personally engraved. In addition, \$2,000 was provided for Presidential Classroom scholarships, which were in varying amounts.

New equipment for the school, valued at \$6,810 and suggested by Principal Joseph List, was a gift from the trustees to the school system.

The general fund from which the trustees yearly dispense money is the accumulation of monies every since the Academy was founded nearly two centuries ago. They have increased greatly, however, in recent years through generous donations of townspeople and former graduates.

The fund today amounts to \$1.1 million, according to Treasurer William J. Kavanagh, and the portfolio is managed by Bank of New England, North
